

Ways and Tools to Send Payments to Kenya

1. Bank Transfers: Use your bank's international wire transfer service to send funds directly to a Kenyan bank account.

To send funds via SWIFT to Kenya here is all you need from the receiver:

- Bank SWIFT code
- Bank code]
- Branch code...First 3 numbers of the recipient's account
- The recipient's account number
- Recipient's Account name
- Bank address.
- <u>PayPal:</u> Send money to Kenyan individuals or businesses using PayPal's secure online platform. Open a business Paypal account and verify. You'll require an email from the receipent.
- 3. <u>WorldRemit:</u> Send money to Kenya through the WorldRemit platform, which allows for convenient online transfers.
- **4.** <u>Western Union:</u> Transfer funds to Kenya through Western Union's global network of agents or online platform.
- 5. <u>Skrill</u>: Make online payments to individuals or businesses in Kenya using the Skrill digital wallet.

Payoneer: Send payments to Kenyan freelancers or businesses through the Payoneer platform. High transaction fees since the receipt will need to withdraw to their Kenyan bank account.

<u>Remitly:</u> Transfer money to Kenya using Remitly's online service, offering competitive rates and fast delivery.

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<u>Xoom:</u> Send funds to Kenya via Xoom's online platform, which provides secure and fast international money transfers.

<u>Payza:</u> Make payments to Kenyan recipients using Payza's online payment platform.

TransferWise: Send money to Kenya with TransferWise's low-cost and transparent international transfer service.

<u>Wave:</u> Use Wave's digital platform to send payments to Kenyan recipients, particularly suited for small businesses and freelancers.

<u>Venmo</u>: If the recipient has a U.S.-based bank account, you can use Venmo's peer-to-peer payment service to send funds.
